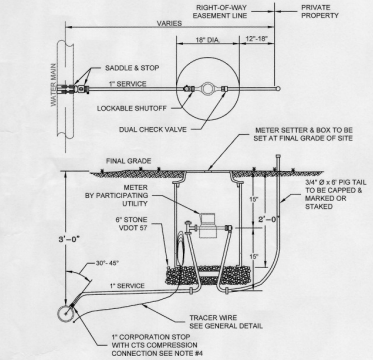


WESTERN VIRGINIA WATER AUTHORITY DETAILS

1. SETTER TO BE A.Y. McDONALD 720-21500003, FORD V8472-10W-11-33 OR APPROVED EQUAL.
2. SADDLES MUST BE USED WITH ALL PLASTIC & DUCTILE IRON PIPE. SERVICE SADDLES SHALL BE USED IN ACCORDANCE WITH WATER DISTRIBUTION PIPING SPECIFICATION. SERVICE SADDLES FOR PLASTIC PIPE SHALL BE POWERFUL MAT, OR WATMA, RMAC-2025, OR 300, OR FORD METER F202 OR F203. FOR DUCTILE IRON PIPE USE THE ABOVE, OR POWERFUL MAT, RMAC-202 OR FORD METER F202.
3. METER BOX SHALL BE CARBON-STEEL, PLASTIC, OR DUCTILE IRON BOX WITH FORD "K" DOMESTIC SERIES FRAME WITH A NODC DOMESTIC 12-25 CX LD WITH SENSUS RECESS AND WVAW LOGO, ADR CORRUGATED HOPE BOX WITH FORD "K" DOMESTIC SERIES FRAME WITH A NODC DOMESTIC 12-25 CX LD WITH SENSUS RECESS AND WVAW LOGO OR APPROVED EQUAL. METER BOX SHALL NOT BE PLACED IN AREAS SUBJECT TO VEHICULAR TRAFFIC. A TRAFFIC BEARING BOX IS REQUIRED. DESIGN ENGINEER SHALL CONSULT WITH PARTICIPATING UTILITY TO DETERMINE SITE SPECIFIC REQUIREMENTS.
4. CORPORATION STOP SHALL BE FORD F1800-4-0AL, MULLER B-2009 OR APPROVED EQUAL.
5. SERVICE SHALL BE "K" TYPE COPPER, OR COPPER TUBE SIZE POLYETHYLENE (PE) 4710, SCOR-4 (200 psi).
6. WHENEVER SIDEWALK EXISTS OR IS PROPOSED, MODIFY METER LOCATION AS DIRECTED.

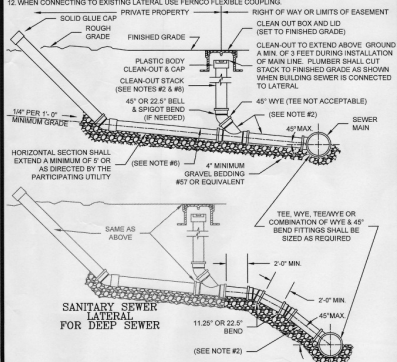

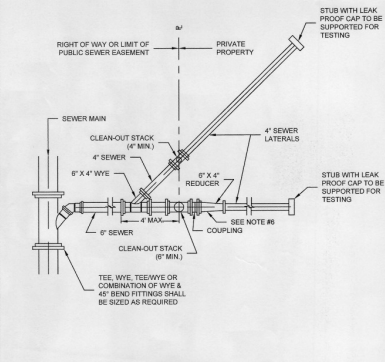
1. TRAFFIC BEARING BOX AND LD REQUIRED IN TRAFFIC AREAS (CAPTOL FOUNDRY V8-47).
2. SEWER LATERAL AND CLEANOUT PIPING SHALL BE ASTM D3034 SDR 35. SEWER LATERAL FITTINGS SHALL BE OF SAME SDR RATING AS THE SEWER MAIN. SCHEDULE 40 SOLVENT WELD PIPE AND FITTINGS MAY BE USED FOR THE SEWER LATERAL AND CLEANOUT ASSEMBLY WITH APPROVAL FROM THE PARTICIPATING UTILITY.
3. ALL PIPE SHALL BE OF SAME SIZE OF THE MAIN FROM THE MAIN TO THE CLEANOUT STACK WYE. (EXCEPT FOR DEEP SEWER, AS SHOWN BELOW).
4. ALL MAIN LINE TAPS ON ACTIVE MAINS SHALL BE PERFORMED BY PARTICIPATING UTILITY.
5. PIPING ON PRIVATE SIDE OF CLEANOUT TO BE INSTALLED PER GOVERNING JURISDICTION REQUIREMENTS.
6. MINIMUM LATERAL SIZE: 4" FOR RESIDENTIAL SERVICE. 6" FOR NON-RESIDENTIAL SERVICE.
7. SEWER CLEANOUTS SHALL BE SAME SIZE AS SEWER LATERAL.
8. MINIMUM COVER FOR ALL SEWER LATERALS SHALL BE THREE (3) FEET.
9. PROPERTY OWNER RESPONSIBLE FOR INSTALLING CLEANOUT ON PROPERTY LINE (IN ACCORDANCE WITH THIS DETAIL). WHEN MAINTENANCE OCCURS.
10. LOWEST SERVED FINISHED FLOOR ELEVATION SHALL BE A MINIMUM OF THREE FEET (3') ABOVE THE TOP OF THE MAIN AT THE POINT WHERE THE SERVICE LATERAL CONNECTS TO THE MAIN.

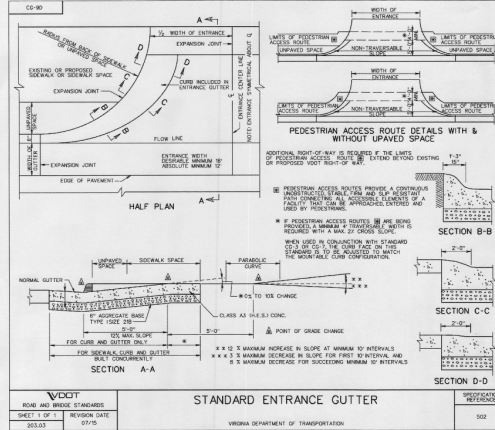
1. TRAFFIC BEARING BOX REQUIRED IN TRAFFIC AREAS.
2. SEWER LATERAL AND CLEANOUT PIPING SHALL BE ASTM D3034 SDR 35. SEWER LATERAL FITTINGS SHALL BE OF SAME SDR RATING AS THE SEWER MAIN. SCHEDULE 40 SOLVENT WELD PIPE AND FITTINGS MAY BE USED FOR THE SEWER LATERAL AND CLEANOUT ASSEMBLY WITH APPROVAL FROM THE PARTICIPATING UTILITY.
3. ALL PIPE SHALL BE OF SAME SIZE OF THE MAIN FROM THE MAIN TO THE CLEANOUT STACK WYE. (EXCEPT FOR DEEP SEWER, AS SHOWN BELOW).

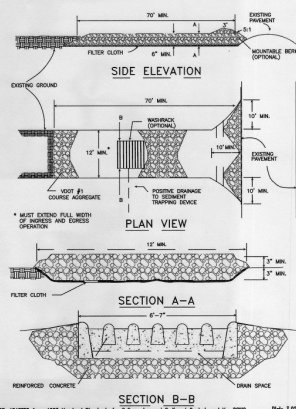

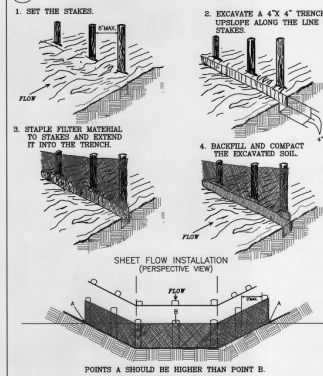
