



1. Right-of-Way Excavation Permit - Prior to the commencement of any digging, alteration or construction within the public right-of-way (streets, alleys, public easements), a right-of-way excavation permit shall be applied for and obtained by the contractor from the City of Roanok

Land Disturbance Permit — An approved erosion and sediment control plan for any borrow/fill sites
associated with the project must be submitted prior to the issuance of a land disturbance permit.
