

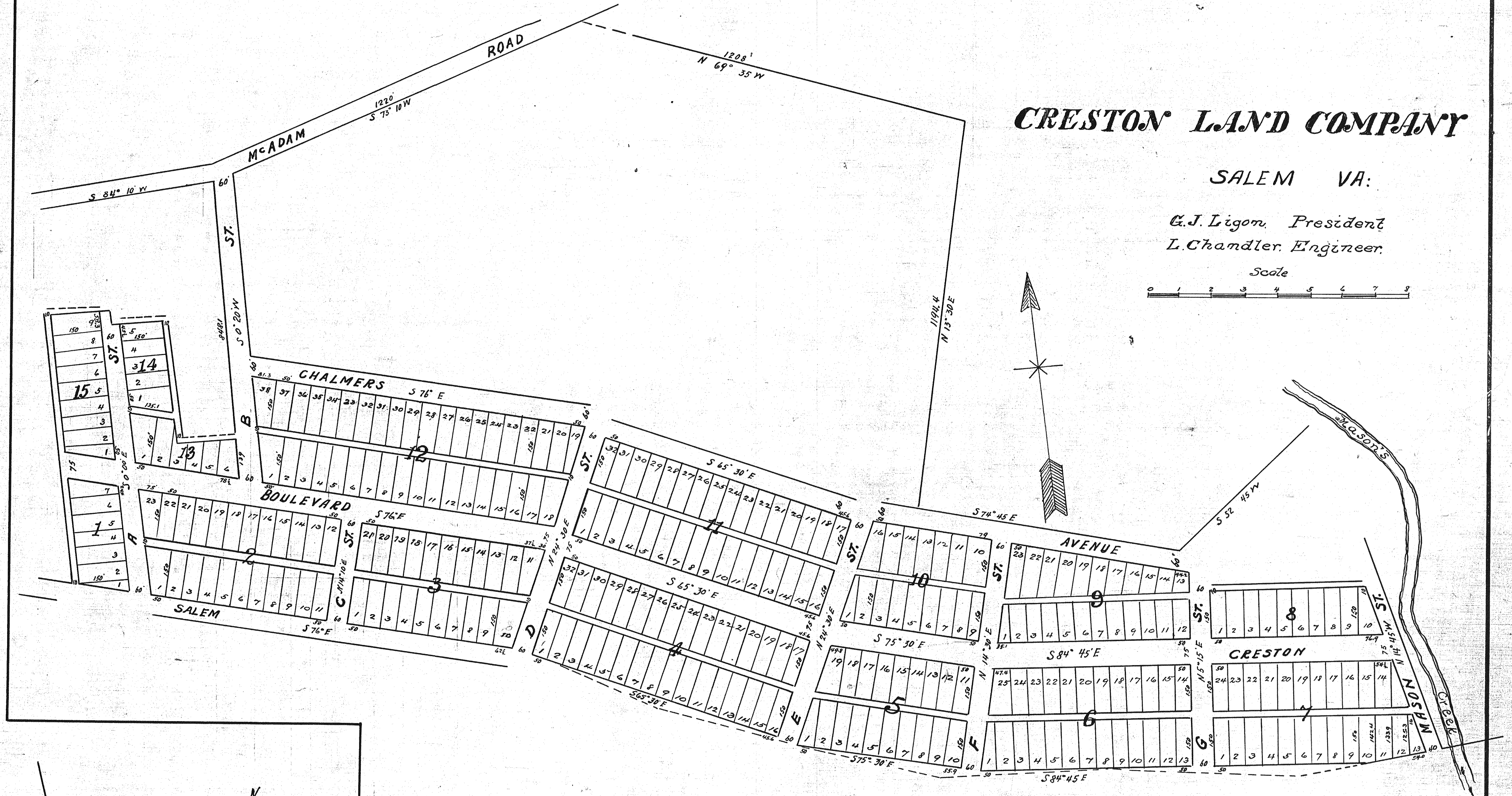
JOS. A. STRICKLER

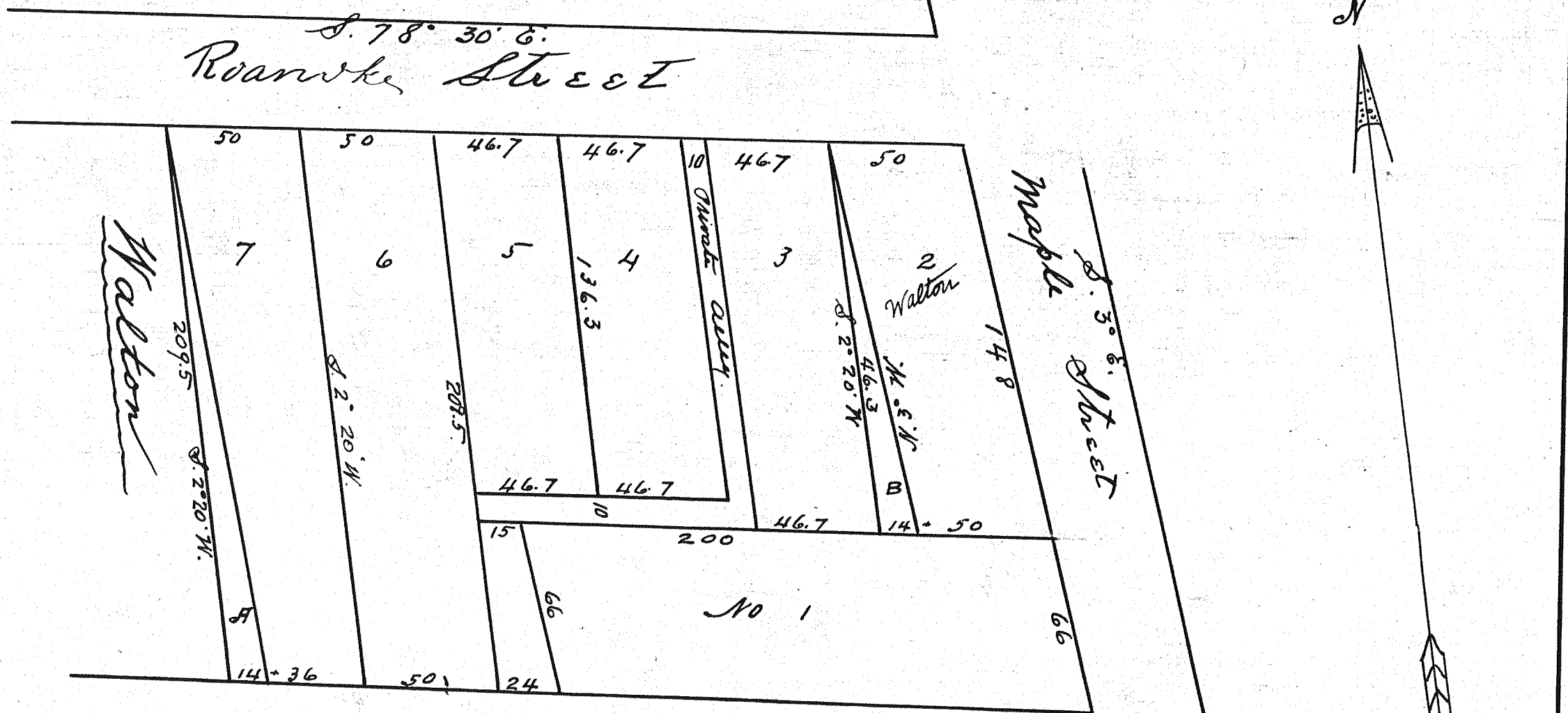
