

ROANOKE DEVELOPMENT CO. PLAN OF SECTION NO. 2

The Roanoke Development Company, a corporation duly chartered, organized and existing, under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Virginia, does hereby certify and state:

1. That it is the sole and exclusive owner and proprietor of the tract of land in Roanoke County, in the State of Virginia, set out on the foregoing plat and subdivided thereon into lots, said tract being bounded and described as follows:
Beginning at a point, the intersection of the centre line of Aunkent Street extended, with the centre line of Virginia Avenue, being also the beginning corner of a certain other plan of lots belonging to the said Roanoke Development Company known as plan of Section No. 4, dated September first, 1891, and duly recorded in the Clerk's Office of the County Court of Roanoke County, Virginia, and being also a point in the outside boundary line of a certain other plan of lots belonging to the said Roanoke Development Company, known as Plan of Section No. 1, which plan is dated September first, 1891, and duly recorded in the said Clerk's Office; thence with the centre line of Virginia Avenue, being also the outside boundary line of the aforesaid Plan of Section No. 1, south seventy-eight degrees thirty minutes east one thousand and eighty-nine and forty-four one hundredths feet; north seventy-three degrees eighteen minutes east twelve hundred and sixty-seven and ninety-five one hundredths feet to the intersection of the northerly line of Rivermont Avenue extended; thence along the northerly line of Government Avenue and partly with the outside boundary line of the aforesaid Plan of Section No. 1, south sixty-two degrees twenty-six minutes east fourteen hundred and sixty-eight and fourteen one hundredths feet to a point; thence crossing said Rivermont Avenue, south twenty-seven degrees thirty-four minutes west sixty feet to the southerly side thereof; thence leaving the same, south fourteen degrees three minutes west five hundred and thirty-four and eighty-one one hundredths feet crossing the head of Edmond Avenue to the southerly side of Edmond Avenue; thence south twenty-seven degrees thirty-four minutes west, crossing the head of Castlewood Avenue and Warrington Avenue; five hundred and twenty-five feet to the southwesterly side of a twenty feet wide alley; thence with the same north sixty-two degrees twenty-six minutes west two thousand and eighty feet to the southeasterly side of Sussex Street; thence with the same south twenty-seven degrees thirty-four minutes west two hundred and ten feet to the southwesterly side of Rockbridge Avenue; thence with the same north sixty-two degrees twenty-six minutes west three hundred and nineteen and twenty-one one hundredths feet to a point; thence still with the same north seventy-eight degrees thirty minutes west, thirty feet to the centre line of Aunkent Street; said centre line being also a line in the outside boundary line of the aforesaid Plan of Section No. 4; thence with the said centre line north eleven degrees thirty minutes east nine hundred and twenty-one and eighty-six one hundredths feet to the Place of beginning. Containing eighty-five and twenty-seven one hundredths acres.
2. That the foregoing subdivision of said tract of land as appears in said plat is with its free consent and in accordance with its desire under the authority of its Board of Directors, and under and virtue of an Act of the General Assembly of Virginia approved on the 5th day of March, 1888, entitled "An Act Providing for the Subdivision of Tracts of Land into Lots or Parcels and for the record of Plat thereof," and the supplement thereto, and that it has subdivided the said tract of land into lots as appears and is shown by the said foregoing plat, the said plat to be known as Plan of Section No. 2.
3. The Roanoke Development Company reserves for itself its successors and assigns the fee in all streets and alleys marked upon this plat and all other which it may hereafter lay out subject to the use of the same by the public as highways but said use by the public, is however, to be subject to the use of the said Company its successors and assigns for the purpose of constructing therein railroads, whether to be run by steam, electricity, horses, or any other motive power, and also for the purpose of locating therein pipes for the conveyance of water, gas, steam, and for other purposes, street lamps, sewers, culverts, and all wires under or above ground, and electric poles, conduits and appliances necessary for illuminating purposes, fire alarms, telephones, and for the conveyance of electric currents for all other uses and purposes. It also reserves the right to modify this plan by changing size of blocks and lots, width, direction and location of streets, avenues and alleys, and by abolishing the same, provided no such change shall be made in such portions of streets, avenues and alleys as may be bounded by or pass through blocks in which one or more lots may have been previously sold, without the consent in writing of the owners of such lots. It further reserves the right of establishing and fixing grades upon any and all streets and alleys, and making such alterations in said grades when established as to it shall seem advisable, without being in damages or otherwise, to any purchaser or purchasers of property from it or his or their assigns, by reason of any such change of grade.
