

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, that the National Investment Company, a corporation chartered and organized under the laws of the State of Virginia, and the owner and proprietor of the following described tract of land in the County of Roanoke, State of Virginia, bounded and described as follows, to wit:-
 BEGINNING at a post in a stone fence, corner to the lands of John Hoover, Mrs. Rogers and W.W. 
