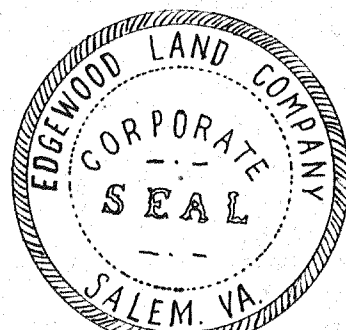


MAP OF EDGEWOOD

This instrument made this 24th day of March 1908 by Edgewood Land Company. Witnesseth that the subdivision of land owned by said company as it appears in this plot is with the consent and in accordance with the desire of said Company, and the right to lay water, gas and sewer pipes, put up electric light lines and electric railways over and along the streets in said company is hereby reserved unto the said company, or to whom it may assign said rights. Witness the signature of said Company by M.M. Caldwell, President and the seal of said company duly attested by J.D. Logan, its Secretary.
