The above subdivision of that certain tract or parcel of land, situate in the County of Roanoke, Virginia, and more particularly described as follows, to wit: BEGINNING at the junction of the center of Murray Road with the center of the Southside Roanoke and Salem Railroad at 112° W. 40.06 ft. to the line of the right-of-way of the Virginian Railway; thence with same 1163.45 W 333.4 ft. to a point of some lot the boundary line of Westland Corporation and the Wm Cook land; thence with said boundary line S 8° 12' E passing a planted stone at 274.4 ft. a total distance of 544.1 to the center of the Southside Roanoke and Salem Railroad; thence with the center of the same in a general north-easterly direction a total distance of 230.93 ft. to the place of beginning, and known as lot 161, in Section No. 2, as shown on the map of Westland, made by Smith-Bradford and Company, Eng'rs May 6th 1919, and being the same real estate conveyed to I.
