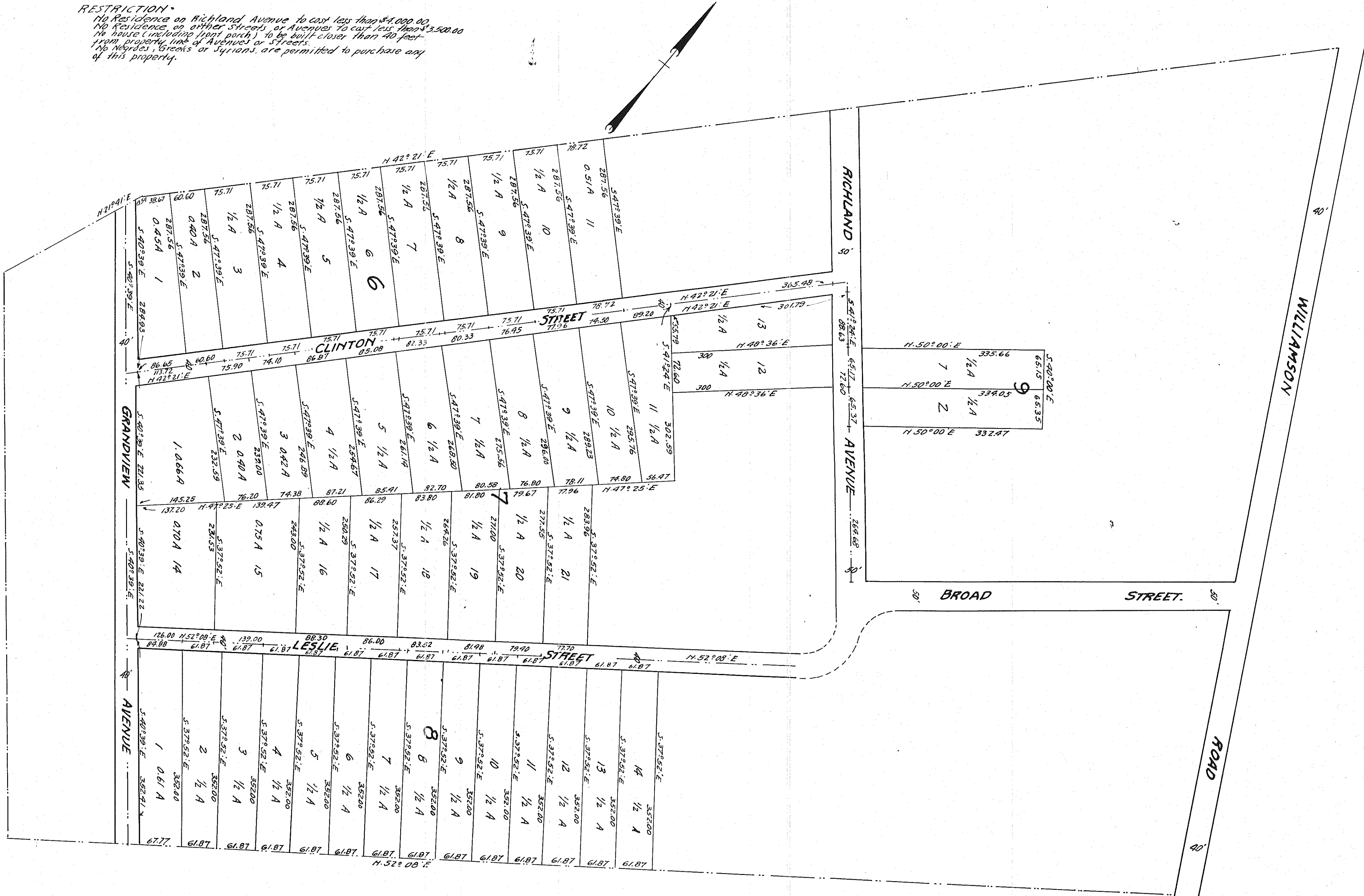


RESTRICTION:
