



It also reserves the right to modify this plan by changing the size and shape of lots and lots, width, grade, direction and location of streets, avenues and alleys, and of advertising or closing alleys or streets, provided no such streets or alleys shall be abolished where the same abut on or pass through blocks in which one or more lots may have been previously sold, without the consent in writing of the owners of such lots. The streets and alleys laid out on this map are not dedicated to the public, but are expressly reserved by the Corporation to be used, enjoyed, subject to the conditions above stated by those owning and occupying lots shown hereon; and the use of the same by the public shall not be treated or construed as a dedication thereof to public uses.


