

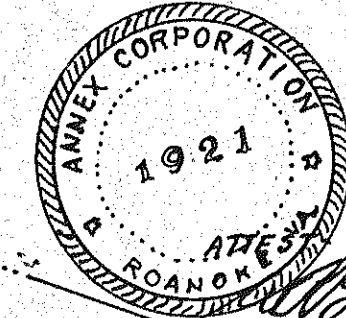
REVISED MAP SHOWING SUBDIVISION OF RALEIGH COURT ANNEX

It also reserves the right to modify this plan by changing the size of blocks and lots, width, grade direction and location of streets, avenues and alleys, and abolishing or claiming same, provided same do not abut do or pass through block in which one or more lots may have been previously sold, without the consent of owners of such lots.

The annexed plat dated July 13th 1925, being the revised map showing subdivision of the tract or parcel of land located in Roanoke County, Virginia, and designated as Raleigh Court Annex is hereby adopted, the outside boundaries of said land being as follows to-wit:-
Beginning at a point in the center of Warrington Road corner to the C.S. McRae property and to the northerly side of Brandon Avenue; thence along the center of Warrington Road N. 3° 35' E. 955.4 feet more or less to the line of the Evergreen Burial Part; thence along the southerly boundary line of said Evergreen Burial Part S. 70° 10' E. 1110.0 feet more or less to a point, corner to Barbour Heights property; thence with same S. 11° 58' W. 632.4 feet to the northerly side of Brandon Avenue; thence along the northerly side of Brandon Avenue S. 77° 02' W. 149.6 feet more or less to an angle point on the said northerly side of Brandon Avenue; thence continuing with same, N. 89° 12' W. 824.8 feet, more or less to the place of beginning.
