as property of S.T. CARNER and WIFE.

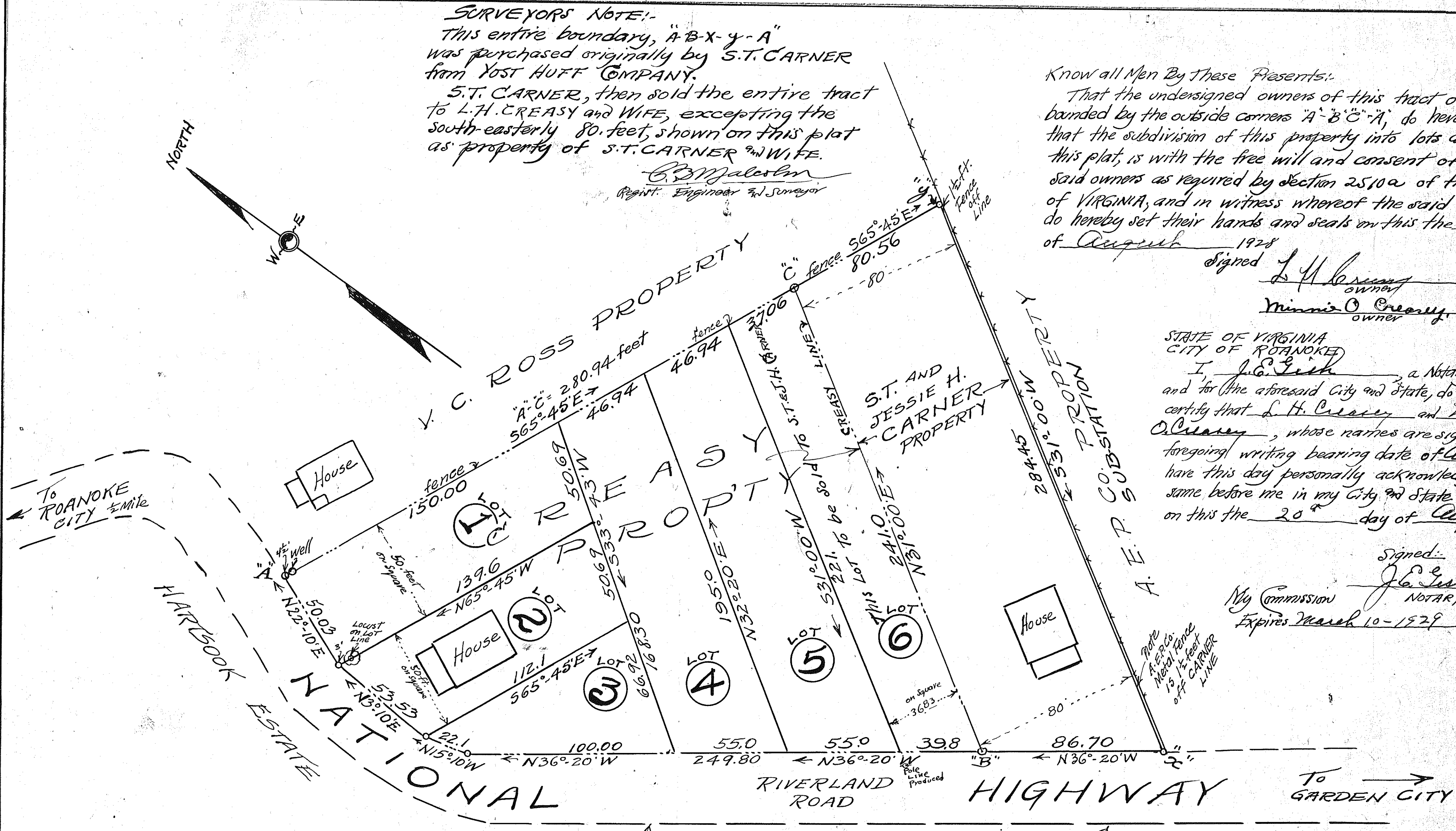
