

The undersigned owners of a tract of land lying in Roanoke County, Virginia, and described as follows, to-wit: Beginning at a double and single Chestnut and black oak in a flat near a small branch (at 1); thence with the old patent granted to Absalom Smith 578°W 66 poles crossing a branch to four black oaks (at 1); thence 561°W 134 poles crossing the three small branches and three spanish oaks and a pine (at 2); thence 581½°W 123 poles crossing the branch at 23 poles to 2 Chestnuts and a black oak (at 3); thence N73°W 145 poles to a Chestnut oak on Thomas line (at 4); thence with Thomas line N7½°E 12 poles to a Stake on a line of George Chambers survey (at 5); thence N84°E 445 poles with said Chambers to the beginning and containing 108 Acres, do declare and certify that the boundary lines as shown on this map is with our free will and consent, in accordance with Section 5218, Code of Virginia. 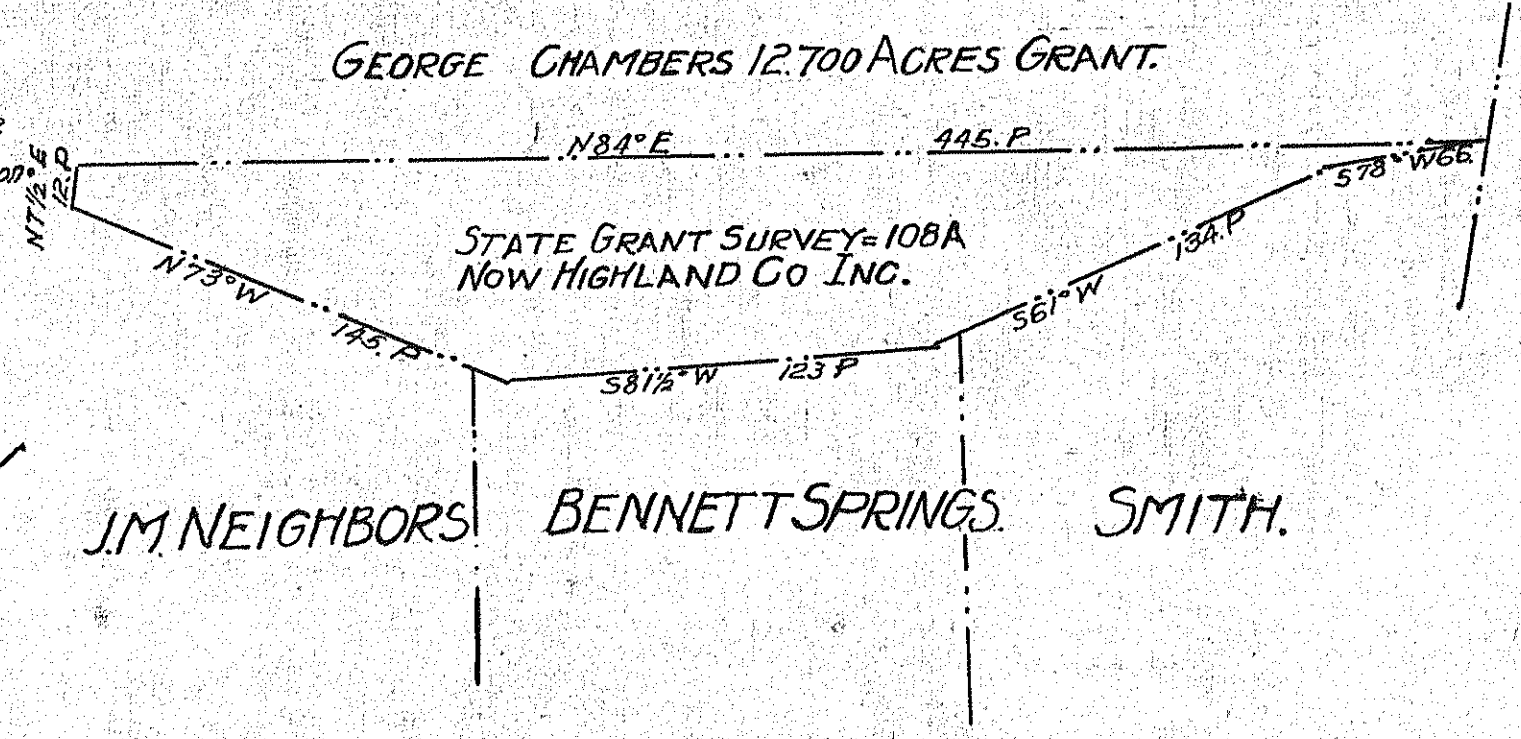
