 that they have subdivided this land into lots as shown hereon,

 The owners hereby dedicate the streets as shown hereon to the County
 of Roanoke in fee simple and they do further as a condition precedent to the
 approval of this plat and subdivision and the acceptance of
 the dedication of the streets shown hereon by the board of
 Supervisors of Roanoke County, Va. on their own behalf
 and for and on account of their heirs, successors, and
 devisees and assigns specifically release the County of
 Roanoke and the Virginia Department of Highways from
 any and all claim or claims for damages which said
 owners, their heirs, successors, devisees and assigns may
 or might have against the County of Roanoke or
 Virginia Department of Highways by reason of establishing
 proper grade lines on and along such streets as shown
 hereon, and by reason of doing the necessary grading,
 cutting or filling for the purpose of placing such streets upon
 the proper grade as may from time to time be established
 by said County or Virginia Department of Highways and
 said County or Virginia Department of Highways shall not
 be required to construct any retaining wall or walls
 along the streets and property lines thereof.

RESERVATIONS & RESTRICTIONS

The following restrictions are made covenants running with the title
 to the lots shown hereon for a period of 30 years from the date of
 recordation of this map.

- No structure shall be erected on any lot shown hereon other than
 private dwellings with necessary outbuildings, nor shall more than
 one dwelling be erected on any one lot shown hereon.
- No part of any building shall be located nearer to the street line than
 the minimum building line as shown hereon, excepting unenclosed porches.
- No dwelling shall be erected on any lot shown hereon having less
 than 1150 sq. ft. with carport, or 1200 sq. ft. without carport or livable floor space.
- No trailer, basement, shack or garage, barn or other outbuilding shall
 be used at any time for a residence, either temporarily or permanently
 nor shall any residence of a temporary character be permitted.
- The lots shown hereon are subject to the utility and drainage easement
 as shown and also the necessary anchors or guys to electric
 or telephone poles.
- No swine or hogs shall be kept on any lot shown hereon.
- No lot shown hereon shall be used as a parking area for commercial
 vehicles and no noxious or offensive trade or activity shall be carried
 on which may or might become a nuisance to the neighborhood.
- It shall be lawful for any person or persons owning any real
 property in this subdivision to prosecute at law or in equity against
 any person or persons violating or attempting to violate any of
 these covenants and either to prevent him or them from so
 doing or to recover damages.


SURVEY OF WINDSOR PARK
