Final Acceptance/City — The owner or developer shall furnish the City of Roanoke's Planning Building and Development Department with a field surveyed final correct set of as-built plans of the newly constructed storm rain and/or stormwater management facilities prior to final acceptance and issuance of a certificate of occupancy by the City. As-built plans shall be provided in the State Plane Virginia South Coordinate System, NAD 1983, FIPS 4502 Feet, US Survey Feet, Datum NA 83, in the form of 1 paper copy and 1 digital AUTOCAD file.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THE CITY OF ROANOKE CONSTRUCTION PROCEDURE

1. Right—of—Way Excavation Permit — Prior to the commencement of any digging, alteration or construction within the public right—of—way (streets, alleys, public

easements), a right—of—way excavation permit shall be applied for and obtained by the contractor from the City of Roanoke.

2. Land Disturbance Permit - An approved erosion and sediment control plan for any

borrow/fill sites associated with the project must be submitted prior to the issuance

3. Plans and Permits — A copy of the plans as approved by the City (signed by the proper City officials) and all permits issued by the City shall be available at the construction site at all times of ongoing construction.

4. Location of Utilities - The contractor shall verify the location of all existing

5. Construction Entrance - The contractor shall install an adequate construction

entrance for all construction related egress from the site. Size and composition of

6. Streets to Remain Clean — It shall be the responsibility of the contractor to insure that the public street adjacent to the construction entrance remains free of

7. Barricades/Ditches — The contractor shall maintain the integrity of all excavated ditches and shall furnish and ensure that all barricades proper and necessary for the

8. Sewer and Pavement Replacement — Construction of sanitary sewers and the replacement of pavement shall be in accordance with approved standards and

specifications of the City of Roanoke and the Western Virginia Water Authority

9. Approved Plans/Construction Changes — Any change or variation from construction design as shown on the officially approved plans shall be approved by the erosion and sediment control agent prior to said changes or variation in construction being
