

Project Description

A new 14,866 square foot building will be constructed at the corner of Jefferson Street SE and Albemarle Avenue SE in the city of Roanoke, VA. The building is an Ambulatory Surgery Center and will provide medical and surgical treatment to patients. The facility will not provide overnight stays but will be for outpatient treatment only. Adequate parking for patients and employees will be provided on the site. An entrance will be constructed especially for ambulance drop off at the south end of the building.

Stormwater will be routed across the surface and in underground pipes on the property to a detention pond designed per Virginia State Code. Erosion and sediment control will be provided in accordance with Virginia State Code.

Medical waste produced at the facility will be packaged and disposed of in accordance with current OSHA standards. A registered medical waste hauler will provide the removal and disposal service.

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
