

CEWED NOTES

- A MINIMUM COVER OF THREE (3) FEET IS REQUIRED OVER PROPOSED LINES.

- 1. <u>CITY INSPECTIONS</u> TO INSURE THE COORDINATION OF TIMELY AND PROPER INSPECTIONS, A PRE—CONSTRUCTION CONFERENCE SHALL BE INITIATED BY THE CONTRACTOR WITH THE CITY BUILDING INSPECTIONS DEPARTMENT. CALL (703) 981—2222 TO ARRANGE A CONFERENCE AT LEAST THREE (3) DAYS PRIOR TO ANTICIPATED CONSTRUCTION.
- 2. <u>STREET OPENING PERMIT</u> PRIOR TO THE COMMENCEMENT OF ANY DIGGING, ALTERATION OR CONSTRUCTION WITHIN THE PUBLIC RIGHT—OF—WAY (STREETS, ALLEYS, PUBLIC EASEMENTS), A STREET OPENING PERMIT SHALL BE APPLIED FOR AND OBTAINED BY THE CONTRACTOR FROM THE CITY OF ROANOKE.
- 3. <u>PLANS AND PERMITS</u> A COPY OF THE PLANS APPROVED BY THE CITY (SIGNED BY THE PROPER CITY OFFICIALS)






