AN ORDINANCE providing for the purchase of certain pumping equipment for the Boxley Hills Pumping Station; accepting a certain bid made to the City for furnishing and delivering the said equipment; rejecting certain other bids made to the City; and providing for an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED by the Council of the City of Roanoke that:

1. The bid of the Byron Jackson Pump Division of Borg-Warner, Inc., to furnish a twenty-five million gallon per day pump and motor, motor starter and controls, with a delivery time of 210 days, meeting all of the City's specifications and requirements made therefor, for the sum of \$64,703.00 is hereby ACCEPTED.

2. The City's Manager of General Services is hereby authorized to issue the requisite purchase order therefor, incorporating into said order the City's specifications, the terms of said bidder's proposal and the terms and provisions of this ordinance; and upon delivery to the City of said equipment and upon the City's acceptance of the same, the Director of Finance is authorized and directed to make requisite payment to said successful bidder, not to exceed the sum of \$64,703.00, from funds heretofore appropriated for this purpose.
