

ORANGE SITE ROAKOKE	SITE SOLITION DOLLAR DOLLAR	 The property will be developed in substantial conformity with the Development Plan prepared by Hayes, Seay, Mattern & Mattern, dated March 15, 2002, a capy of which is attached to this Petition for Rezoning as Exhibit B, subject to any changes required by the City as part of its Comprehensive Development Plan preview. A congregate home, housing the Women's Residential Recovery Program will in the Women and Children's Building and will have a maximum of twenty-four (24) women program participants, who will live in the Women and Children's Building with their children, In addition to the participants in the Women's Residential Recovery Program, the following programs will be housed in the Women and Children's building: The Family Shelter (12 units/48 beds maximum); the Female Transient Program (1 unit/10 beds maximum); the Infirmary (2 units/12 beds maximum); the Residential staff (2 units). No beds other than for those programs and personnel identified in this paragraph (and subject to the maximum numbers of identified in this paragraph) will be added to the Women's and Children's Building. The exterior of the Women and Children's Building will be in substantial conformity with he elevations prepared by Hayes, Seay, Mattern & Mattern dated March 15, 2002, and attached to this Petition for Rezoning as Exhibit B, subject to any changes required by the City as part of its Comprehensive Development Plan review. The number of beds for male transients win the Rescue Mission will not exceed 101. Except for those shown on the Development Plan, no other buildings will be constructed on the property.
