

PAINTING

Paint shall be Tnemec or approved equal and shall be delivered in sealed and labeled containers and applied in accordance with manufacturer's recommendations. Painting shall consist of one prime coat, a touch up coat and two finish coats. Where piping is shipped with a bituminous coating, two coats of Tnemec's Tar Bar shall be used in lieu of the prime coat.

All piping, valves, pumps and metal work under this contract shall be painted except where of copper, aluminum, plastic or galvanized. If piping is covered, pipe covering shall be painted.

For shop prime coat use Tnemec's No. 77 Chem-Prime followed by a field touch up of marred areas using No. 77 Chem-Prime and followed by two coats of No. 18 Tufcoat. Woodwork shall receive one coat of No. 100 architectural wood primer, followed by two coats of Tnemec Gloss No. 2.
