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The floor plan illustrates the layout of the Central Atrium (205) and its connections to adjacent spaces. Key elements include:

- Room Labels:** NORTH CORR. 201, CE, CENTRAL ATRIUM 205, EAST CORRIDOR 206, SOUTH CORR. 207.
- Dimensions:** 10'-0" (width of North Corridor), 4'-0" (width of planter area), 1'-0" (width of water feature), 3'-0" (width of circular feature), 11'-0" (width of planter area), 1'-0" (width of water feature).
- Features:** NEW EXIT SIGN, PLANTINGS, T. (Tables), WATER FEATURE, LIGHTWEIGHT CONCRETE PAVERS LOOSE-LAID OVER EXISTING RUBBER MEMBRANE, EXISTING WATER SUPPLY.
- Room Numbers:** A1-1A.1, A1-1A, A1-1A.2, A1-1A, 207 C, 207 B.

The floor plan of the Central Atrium (205) is a long, narrow rectangular space. At the top is the North Corridor (201) and at the bottom is the South Corridor (207). To the right is the East Corridor (206). The atrium contains several rooms: a diamond-shaped room at the top, a large oval room in the center, and a smaller oval room below it. Circulation paths are indicated by dashed lines with arrows and numbered hexagons (1-6). Path 1 shows a loop from the North Corridor, through the diamond room, and back to the North Corridor. Path 4 shows a loop from the North Corridor, through the diamond room, down to the center oval room, and back to the North Corridor. Path 5 shows a loop from the North Corridor, through the diamond room, down to the bottom oval room, and back to the North Corridor. Path 6 shows a loop from the North Corridor, through the diamond room, down to the center oval room, and back to the North Corridor.

6. REMOVE PORTION OF WOOD TRIM.
